HOUR OF CODE

The Hour of Code is a global movement introducing tens of millions of students worldwide to computer science. The goal is to inspire kids to learn more about computers and coding, while leaving all with a feeling of empowerment from the experience.

What is the Hour of Code?

The Hour of Code began as a one-hour coding challenge to give students a fun introduction to computer science. It has become a global learning and awareness event. **HourOfCode.com** offers hundreds of one-hour activities in over 48 different languages for grades kindergarten and up. Activities require no experience and can be run on laptops, tablets, and smart phones. (Some activities don't even require a computer at all.)

The Hour of Code takes place every year during **Computer Science Education Week**, which is the first week in December. At MCP, we will be offering **HOUR OF CODE** workshops on three different days. The dates are December 4th at 10:00 am, December 6th at 2:00 pm, and December 8th at 10:00 am.

CURRICULUM UPDATE
