

<b>Class Title:</b>	Visual Arts
<b>Grade Level:</b>	High School
<b>Subject:</b>	Fine Arts
<b>Class Description:</b>	<p>The student will explore art through using various artistic mediums and/or studying the styles of famous artists. Class will consist of lecture/notes, correcting and answering questions on coursework at home, quizzes, and independent and group work-time when available. Students will be expected to complete at least two-three hours of coursework outside of class each week.</p> <p>This class meets the graduation requirement for the State of Washington and Kennewick School District and meets at least one Common Core Standard. This course is a yearlong course for 2018-2019. Students who successfully complete the course have the potential to earn 1.0 credit.</p> <p>The estimated instructional hours for this class are 5 per week.</p>

<b>Learning Goals/ Performance Objectives:</b>	
<b>Learning Activities:</b>	<p>The student's progress will be based primarily on participation and effort. Student bring either the actual art projects or pictures of the projects to monthly progress meetings. If studying artists, student will report who has been studied at monthly meetings.</p>

Every month progress will be determined by the HQ teacher of this course based on the question: "Will the student master the majority of his performance objectives by the end of the course?" The HQ teacher will take into consideration ALL factors (including student life situation, effort, attitude, etc.) when making this professional judgment.

Each month, the student will be expected to master approximately 10% of the yearly goals for this class (or 20% of semester goals), with the majority of the goals being met by the end of the year (or semester.) The mastery of any one goal may be an on-going process and some goals may overlap or be difficult to measure. Evaluation of progress toward the mastery of the goals will be based on monthly completion (or progress toward completion) of the learning activities that are designed to provide the means to achieving the goals of the learning plan. With that said, monthly progress can still be marked satisfactory based on the professional judgment of the teacher that the student will complete the majority of the goals of the course.

Monthly assessments will be completed by the consultant/certified teacher. Monthly Progress will be marked satisfactory or unsatisfactory based on the professional judgment of the certified teacher using parent input, work samples, and monthly assessments.

Final Grading: Course grades are weighted towards summative tests in the courses.
