Become familiar with different types of writing (non-fiction, fables, poetry, fiction) 4. Begin to recognize sight words 5. Identify and produce words that rhyme 6. Identify characters and setting 7. Identify different parts of a book (title, author, beginning and ending) 8. Identify upper and lower case letters 9. Learn letter sounds, vowel combinations, and blends to begin sounding out words 10. Learn to use pictures and book clues for comprehension, prediction, and word meaning 11. Put events in the correct order to retell a story 12. Recognize familiar labels and signs 13. Relate personal experiences to what is read 14. Show understanding of text in a variety of ways (drawing, retell, etc.) 15. Use text, pictures, letters, words to communicate in writing 16. Recognize and print upper and lower case letters 17.
